# **Create Your Own Patriotic Art OR Analyze Patriotic American Symbols**

You have two choices to help you better understand how *nationalism* is promoted in America through images and symbols. Your first choice - **option A** - is to create art that reflects pride in your country by presenting symbols an interesting, meaningful and colorful manner. You must create the art – NO COMPUTER IMAGES or CLIPART - and have the following elements to be considered for full credit:

- A strong sense of "*nationalism*" that clearly shows pride in your country. Select at least five (5) items that Americans, as well as people around the world, would recognize as unique and symbolic of the United States. More than the minimum, as always, is perfectly acceptable! You may also include a *patriotic* quote if you wish, but this is not required. The quote does not count as one of the five symbols.
- The art must be colorful. Take the time to make your images come to life in a manner that would make any red blooded American stop and shed tears of joy in public upon witnessing your creation!

- Make sure you cite the source of your research for each of the symbols you have studied. This includes specific website used for both the image and any information used to prepare your summary.
- YOUR RESEARCH FOR EACH OF THE THREE SYMBOLS WILL INCLUDE AN IMAGE AND TWO PARAGRAPHS. THE FIRST PARAGRAPH WILL IDENTIFY THE ELEMENTS OF NATIONALISM FOUND IN THE SYMBOL. THE SECOND PARAGRAPH WILL EXPLAIN WHAT THOSE SPECIFIC ELEMENTS MEAN AND HOW THEY PROMOTE AMERICAN NATIONALISM. CITE ALL SOURCES. DO NOT PLAGERIZE. YOUR VOCABULARY WILL BETRAY YOU!

Paragraph One will identify all of the elements – or parts – of the symbol that you are analyzing. This might include words that are part of a motto of saying. What are the elements and what do they mean?



Paragraph Two will be your explanation of how the elements are used to promote ideas of nationalism or patriotism in the United States. Every country wants their citizens to have pride in their country. How do these symbols work on US?
