2.	Describe at least three (3) ways in which women contributed to the Revolutionary effort. Explain which one of these roles you felt was the most important in helping the American <i>colonists</i> to victory.
3.	According to the eyewitness accounts (<i>primary sources</i>) you just read, how do you think these young people felt about the violence they viewed and experienced? Explain how <u>you</u> might have reacted.
4.	Explain why <i>colonists</i> reacted differently to the war. Why were some <i>patriots</i> while others where <i>loyalists</i> ? Which of these accounts was the most "personal" example of war in your opinion?
